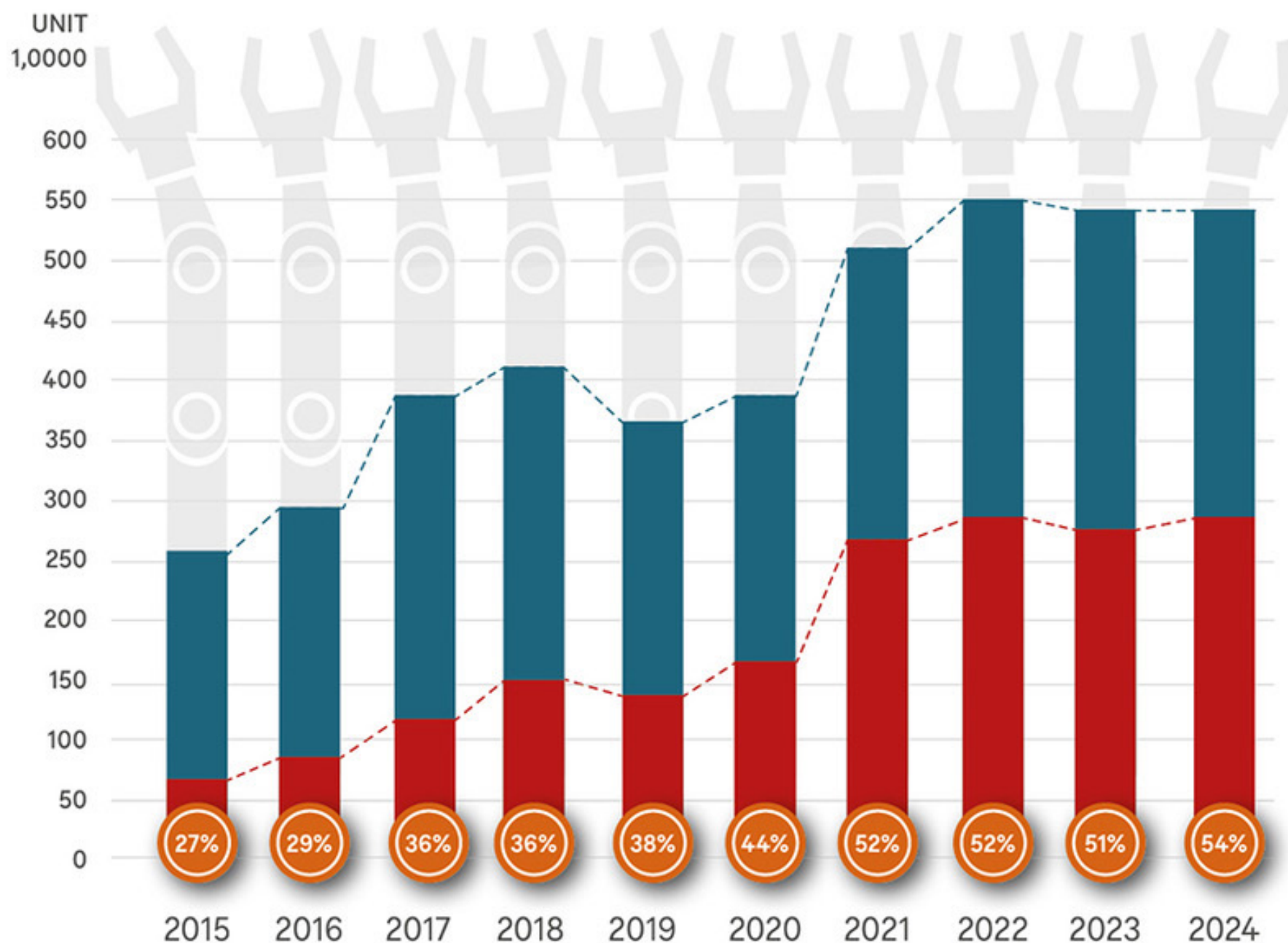


# Global industrial robot market: China continues to set the pace

## Weekly Facts & Figures.

- **China still dominates industrial robot demand:** 295,045 new installs in 2024 = 54% of the global ~542,076 total.
- **High-volume adoption is now structural, not a one-off surge:** After a ~60% YoY jump in 2021 (to >268,000 units), installs stabilized at a high level (around 290k in 2022, dip in 2023, rebound in 2024).
- **Policy tailwind is explicit:** The 15th Five-Year Plan (2026–2030) frames industrial upgrading/automation as a “competitiveness and resilience agenda,” aimed at stronger industrial foundations and supply-chain security.
