
EU-China trade: Rising Russian ties and market imbalances fuel European frustration

- EU trade deficit with China: China exports more than twice as much to the EU as it imports.
- Structural concerns: The EU criticizes Chinese overcapacity and limited market access as drivers of the imbalance.
- Russia trade imbalance: Since 2018, China has run a trade deficit with Russia, which the EU views critically.
