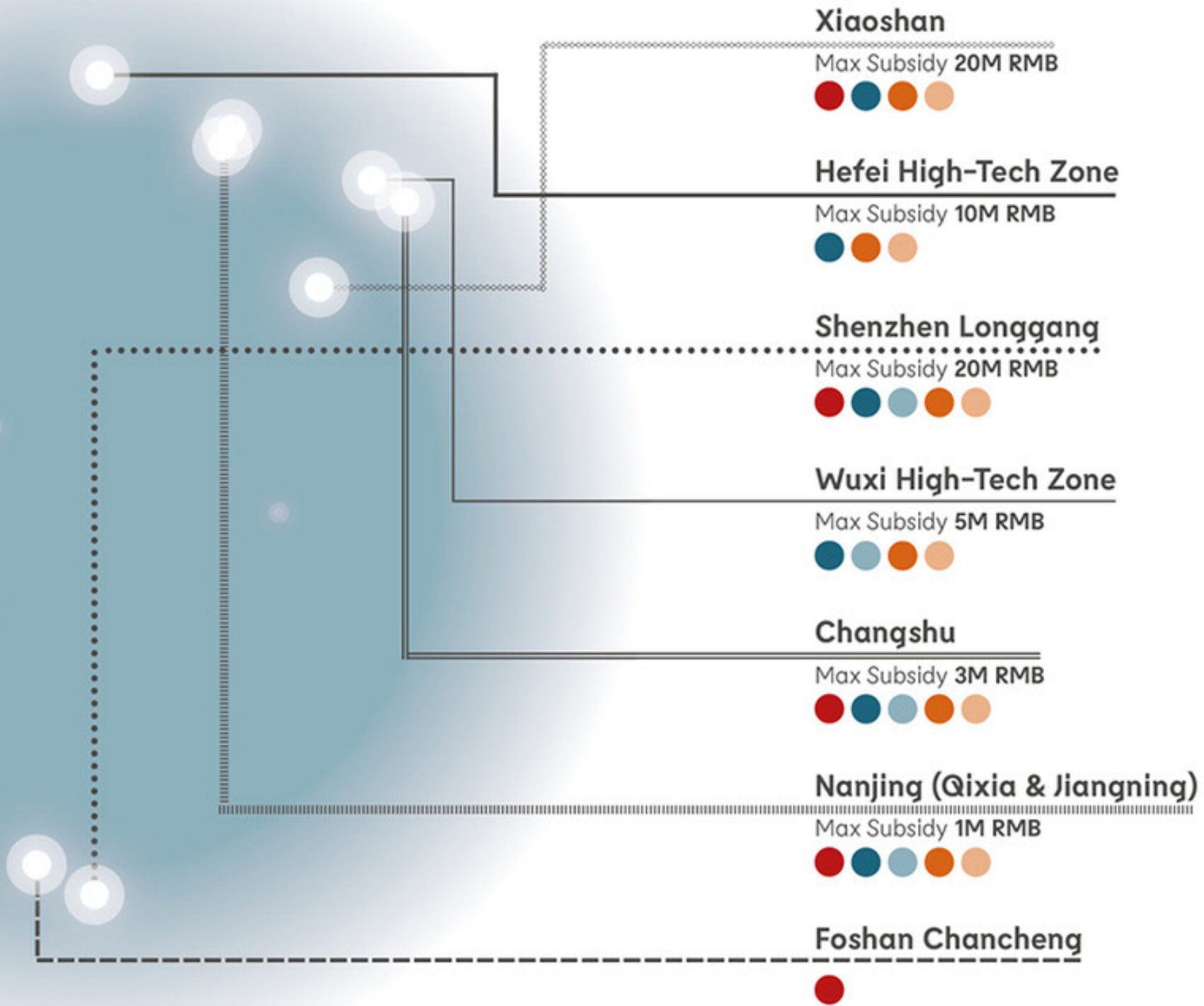


China's OpenClaw push: Districts enter a high-value subsidy race
