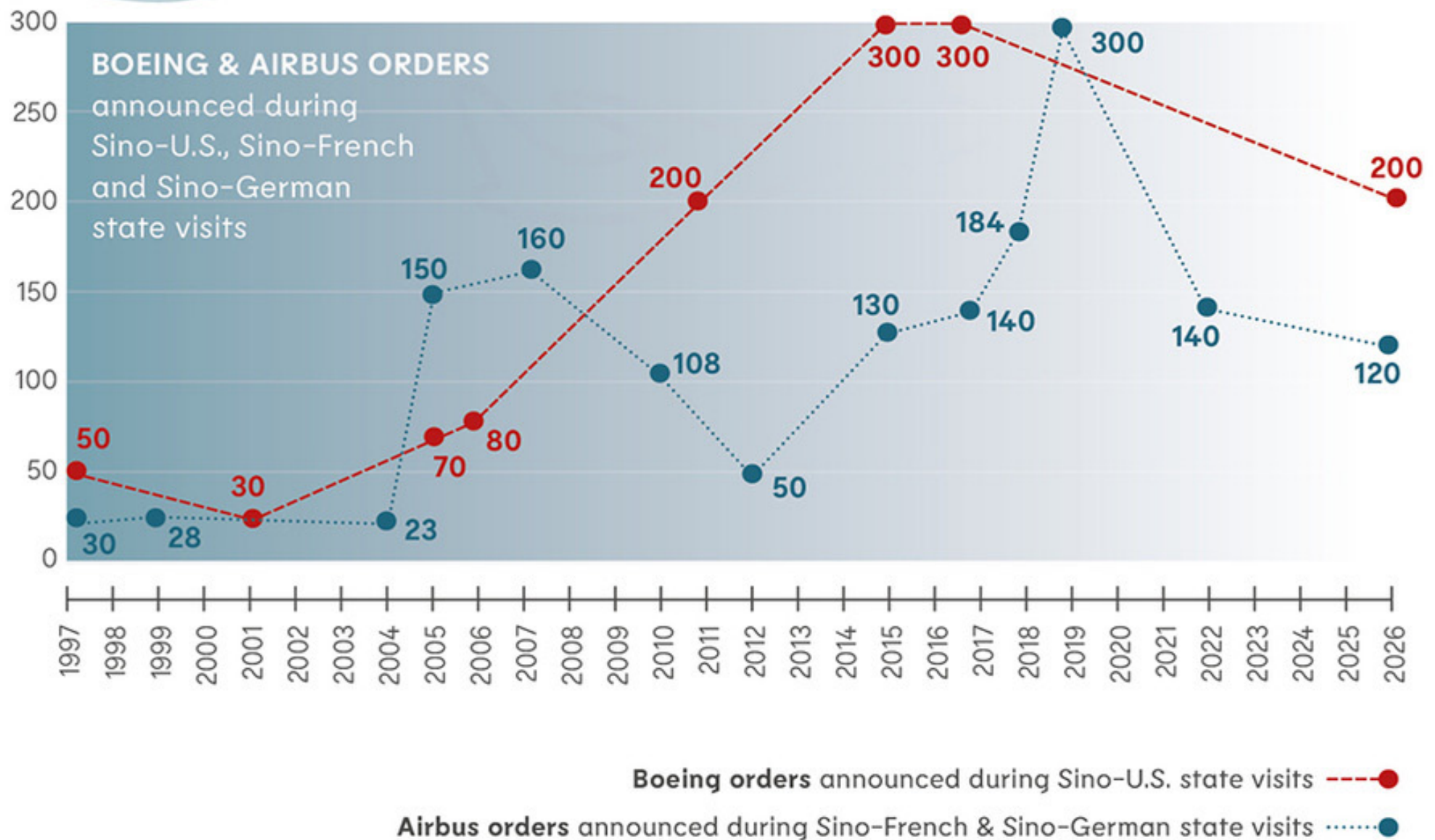


Aircraft diplomacy reloaded:

Boeing orders may shape the next round of U.S.-China trade talks



Weekly Facts & Figures.

- **Boeing order:** Trump said Xi agreed to buy 200 Boeing aircraft on 14 May 2026.
- **Market reaction:** Despite the announcement, Boeing shares fell 4.73% that day.
- **Leverage signal:** China has received almost no Boeing passenger-jet orders since 2017, after a 300-aircraft order during Trump's 2017 visit.
